Tourtière Making Time!

We are planning to make approx **400** large tourtières.

We will do 2 sessions of 200 pies each.

We will need to cook 10 batches of 16.5lbs each session.

The bottoms are made and in the freezers as well as the pastry for the tops.



Each session will take 2 days:

The first to cook, stir, cool and put the meat in the fridge.
The second to roll tops, make boxes, fill pies, box and freeze the tourtières.
We will be circulating sign-up sheets looking for **MANY** helpers.

Thursday September 19th	7:30am starting pastry preparation/rolling 8:30am filling pies with meat

Session 2:

Wednesday October 16th	7:30am cooking/stirring the meat 8:30am coolers/clean-up
Thursday October 17th	7:30am starting pastry preparation/rolling 8:30am filling pies with meat
